### Code of Conduct for Students

- 1. Students shall attend classes regularly, punctually and sincerely.
- 2. Student shall attend and participate actively in all the programmes, activities and competitions conducted by the institution.
- 3. They should wear uniforms on all the days except the days specified by the institution.
- 4. Students who remain absent for more than a week shall be terminated from the institution without any prior notice or information.
- 5. It is mandatory for the students to obtain permission, if they can't attend classes owing to personal and health issues.
- 6. Students shall submit assignments in time, appear for tests and examinations without assigning any reason.
- 7. It is strictly instructed that they should not spoil/damage any property of the college-electrical fittings, sanitary fittings, blackboards, lab'equipments etc.
- 8. Students shall visit the library and spend 'an hour a day' in the library.
- 9. If they are not comfortable, come across any problems, they shall report the same to the teachers or the Principal of the college.
- 10. Using mobile in the classroom and in the college campus is strictly prohibited and any violation of the rules shall attract penalty or punishment or both.
- 11. Students shall submit all the documents in time- marks cards, transfercertificates, caste and income certificates and other documents required by the institution.
- 12. Students shall not do anything whichdamage the morale, reputation and integrity of the institution.
- 13. Sexual harassment is completely banned in college campus. In case, if they indulge in such cases, they will be viewed seriously.
- 14. Students shall behave in a very obedient way with the Management, Principal, teaching and non-teaching staff.
- 15. Students shall meet the Principal, Teachers and non-teaching staff as and when needed to get their problems solved.
- 16. Studentsshall bring their parents atleast once in a month to appraise them with regard to their attendance, performance in tests, midterm examinations and other academic activities.
- 17. Students should focus only on skills, values, scholastic competence and be able to acquire competence in soft skills, communication skills etc.
- 18. They should excel in academics and co-curricular, extra-curricular activities actively andmake use of the programmes.
- 19. Students shall pay 'three times' of the cost of the lost materials, books, property, equipments, glasswaresetc., or shall be terminated from the institution without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- 20. Students shall strictly adhere to the rules, regulations of the Institution, Management and the University.
