We've conducted economic survey in the 'Email nagari' with the purpose of know the economic condition of the people of this area.

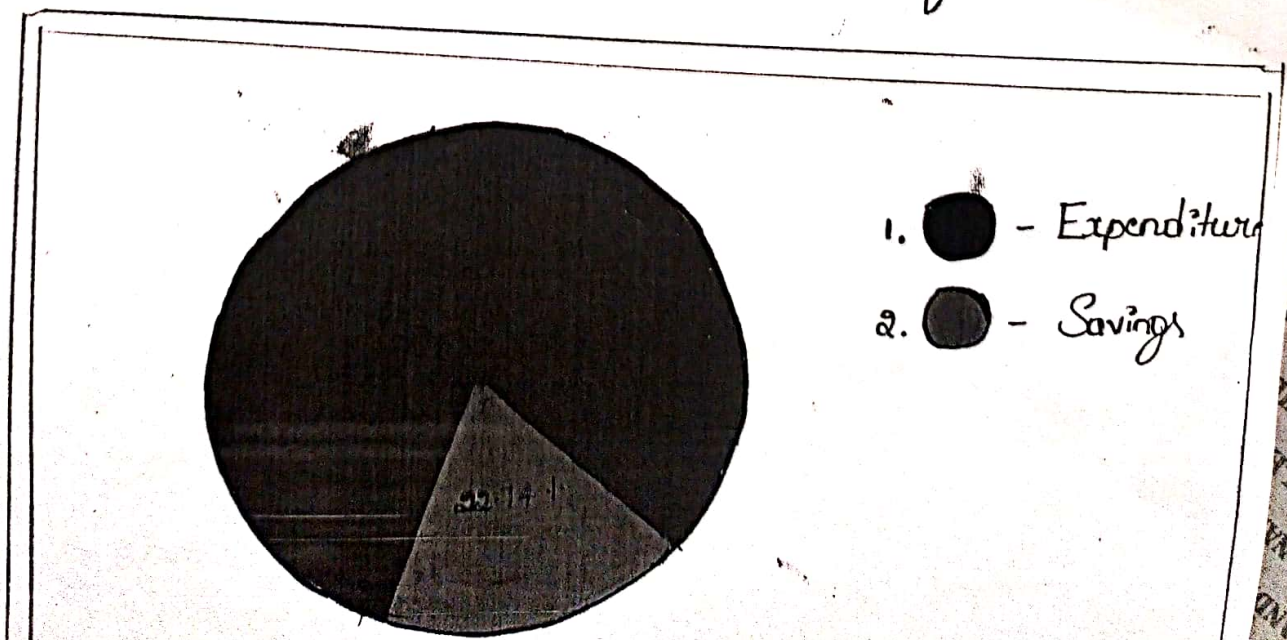
In that we collected information about the total members of their family and total studying and working ~~us~~ members, total ~~expenses~~ and savings of their families.

The number of members studying were 19 and the total members of working members were 33.

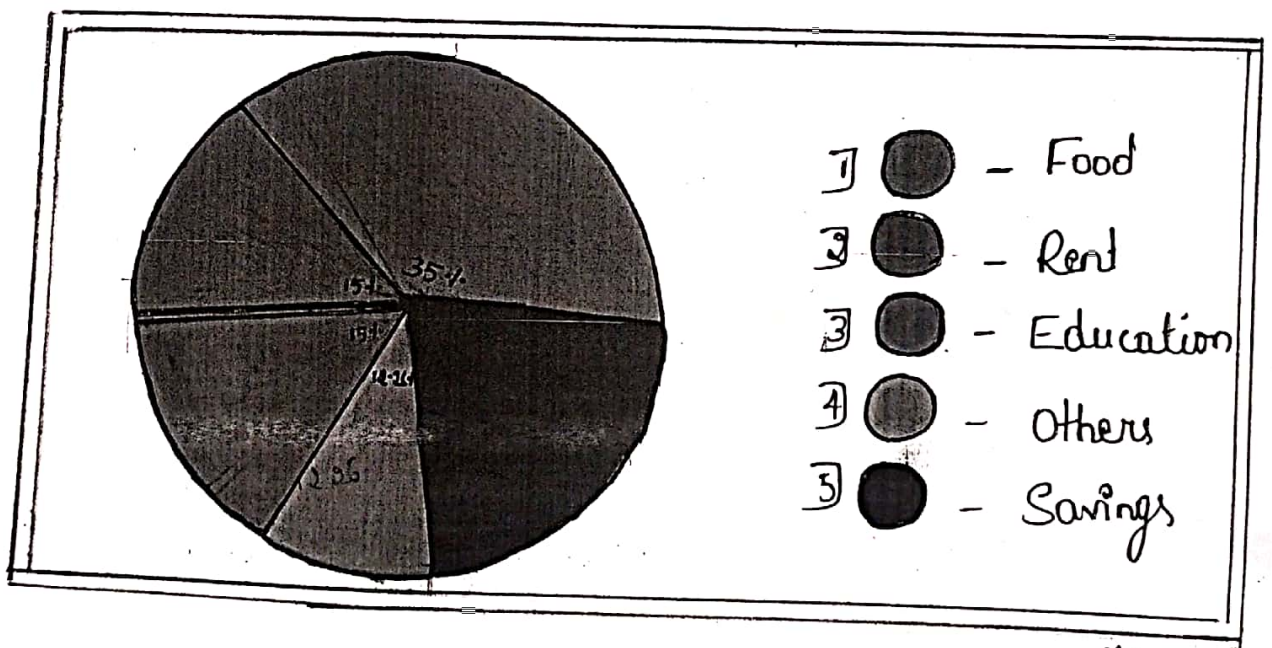
Their monthly average income is 18,250. In that their average expenses is 14,100 and savings is 4,150.
