
Introduction:

- **5. Faculty**: Feedback for revision of syllabus is carried out after two years before actual revision of syllabus and recommendations will be sent for University.






Feedback Analysis of Students on Teachers 2019-20:




More than half of the students are happy with the teaching skills & methods adapted by the teachers.




Feedback analysis shows that majority of the students agree that faculties are having very good teaching skills and complete the syllabus well in advance.


Feedback Analysis of Students on Teachers 2016-17:




- More than half of the students opined that regularity and time management of classes by teachers is good.


Feedback Analysis of Student on Curriculum and Institution 2019-20:




Feedback Analysis of Student on Curriculum and Institution 2017-18:


Feedback Analysis of Student on Curriculum and Institution 2016-17







- > College office administration need to be improved, opined by majority of the alumni.






















